Description of Exhibit

H2OhMy! is a jurored art competition whose intent is to present a cohesive aesthetic message that communicates the importance of water quality in a unique way that captivates, informs and inspires. The competition is open to all mediums including Drawing, Painting, Printmaking, Photography, Sculpture, Ceramic, Video & Installation. Works will be jurored on the basis of aesthetic excellence as well as the message communicated by the work in terms of clarity and applicability of the content. There is an entry fee of \$25.00 that covers a maximum of 8 images per artist. This image allocation can be used to present up to 2 images per piece.

There will be 8 cash prizes awarded in this competition totaling \$1,000.00. Additional funds raised will go to benefit the Water Quality Forum and water conservation efforts in east TN. Admission into the exhibit will be determined by a committee of 5 creative and environmental professionals including Gregg Schlanger with Austin Peay State University, Marcia Goldenstein with the University of Tennessee, Katie Walberg Co-Founder of the Trash Collective, Jason Scott with the Town of Farragut Department of Engineering & Parc Gibson with Knox County Stormwater Management. Works will be accepted until midnight on July 30, 2010. The exhibit will be held at Ijams Nature Center in Beautiful South Knoxville, TN with a Gala opening to be held on September 10, 2010.

Particulars and Technicalities

Remember, you may submit a maximum of 2 images per piece, up to 4 images (8 images total).

Don't forget to complete payment at the conclusion of your application of via Check, Money Order or Major Credit Card to complete your application. Incomplete applications WILL NOT be considered. Application fees are Non-Refundable.

By submitting this application you as the applicant acknowledge that you understand that an application in and of itself does not guarantee participation in H2OhMy! and that a juroring process is utilized to make this determination. Notification of acceptance and denial will be sent out between August 2nd and August 6th 2010 via Email to the email address provided in the application.

By submitting this application you acknowledge that if accepted you are competing for any of 8 cash prizes that are as follows: First Place (1) (\$300.00), Second Place (1) (\$250.00), Third Place (1) (\$200.00), Honorable Mention (5) (\$50.00).

By submitting this application you give the Water Quality Forum and its partners the right to utilize your submitted imagery as well as resulting imagery associated with H2OhMy! And its presentation For the purpose of promotion and advertisement of H2OhMy! And other Water Quality Forum related projects. This includes, but is not limited to print, web, radio and television broadcast/display.

Delivery and Handling of Work

By submitting this application, you agree that if accepted into the exhibit you will be able to deliver your work in person to Ijams Nature Center in Knoxville, TN on September 14th from 9am-1pm or September 15th from 11am – 3pm or that you will make arrangements with program staff to have your work mailed to Ijams Nature Center by August 15th 2010. Please note that all shipping expenses are the responsibility of the artist. This includes shipping to and from the exhibit space.

The Water Quality Forum and its partners are not responsible for any damages that may occur to an artist or their work under reasonable circumstances to include the handling of work during the hanging and takedown of the exhibition, mailing, etc. It is advised that insurance be taken out with your preferred mail carrier should you decide to mail your work.

Presentation of Work

Work must be display ready. 2D works should be wall hangable unless other means are intended and made available by the artist. 3D work should be ready for floor or pedestal display unless other means are intended. Video/Installation artists must be willing to provide assistance in the presentation of their work which may include providing projects, computer and additional presentation materials that may not be readily available to the Water Quality Forum. Bottom line, if the work gets in we will make it work, we just need to make sure that you will be willing to help out.
